Racial Repair for Educational Debt Program

What is the purpose of the program?

Address the historic role of Forest Hill Church in perpetuating systematic racism by acknowledging our complicity, offering heartfelt repentance and beginning the process of repair.

Help combat racial inequity.

Address debt created from higher education costs.

Who is eligible?

Priority will be given to applicants who are Black, self-identify as female or non-binary, are a Cleveland Heights resident, and who have graduated from a post-secondary program.

How much debt does the program address?

\$35,000 to \$75,000

How many individuals will receive debt elimination?

We will identify one recipient in the first year. As funds are available, we will invite additional applicants.
