WE SHOW GOD'S LOVE

- ADULT SPIRITUAL GROWTH: provides different voices and perspectives with a variety of spiritual growth opportunities to help us all live more fully into the teachings of Christ.
- ABUNDANCE FOOD PANTRY: provides abundant amounts of food to those in need in our community, treats guests with dignity, and encourages many people to help us in this noble effort.
- BLACK HISTORY EDUCATION COMMITTEE: reminds us all Black Lives Matter, really matter.
- CHURCH GROWTH: following Jesus's message of radical inclusion, reaches out with love to welcome every person seeking a faith community; the Visitor Welcome Team employs radical hospitality to encourage a sense of "belonging" at Forest Hill.
- **COMMUNICATIONS:** helps our church communications staff, ministry leaders, and members share messages with clarity, grace, and purpose; those stories define Forest Hill Church as a cherished community of faith and love.
- **DEACONS:** are fully present, listen without judgment, and offer words of hope and encouragement to members and friends of Forest Hill Church. Deacons care for physical and spiritual needs through acts of kindness and compassion.
- **EARTH CARE:** with judicious usage of land, water and energy resources; by recycling of used materials, and by showing concern and care for all God's creatures large and small.
- **ENDOWMENT:** are effective, careful stewards of gifts given to extend the mission of the church in perpetuity; this love is expressed yearly through supplemental funding of initiatives that deepen care, worship and iustice.
- FAMILY, YOUTH, CHILDREN: creates a safe welcoming environment, an inclusive caring community, and engaging joyful programming that nurtures faith in the lives of the incredible children and families of our church.
- **FINANCE:** provides the financial planning and analysis needed by Session to manage the church's finances and expenditures so that the church can continue its expression of love by serving its neighborhood and worshiping God.
- GREATER CLEVELAND CONGREGATIONS: through the Court Watch initiative as one of its efforts, Forest Hill GCC members observe juvenile court proceedings for youth facing bindover to adult court, hold the juvenile court system accountable, and demonstrate God's love for our community's young people.
- IMMIGRATION TASK FORCE: called to love our neighbor as ourselves, the Immigration Task Force shows this love by welcoming new newcomers in our land.
- **JUSTICE:** by answering God's call to walk with our neighbors, we share our abundance through programs that promote social justice action and advocacy that address issues of racial equity, diversity, and inclusion.
- MUSIC PROGRAM: celebrates God's love through joyful sound, singing, ringing and drumming; as the
 psalmist say, we praise God's love with voices, instruments, and rhythm!
- **PERSONNEL:** through thoughtful oversight and genuine care, the committee ensures that each member of our staff feels valued, supported, and recognized for their unique, God-given talents and skills.
- RACIAL EQUITY BUDDIES: demonstrates Jesus' love that "rejoices with the truth" by inviting everyone to seek, understand, and act upon the truth to create equity, justice and freedom.
- RACIAL REPAIR TASK FORCE: selected a Black female to be the first recipient of our Education Debt Relief
 Program. It is our hope, through donations from our church family and others, to be able to select another
 candidate sometime in the near future.
- **SESSION:** faithfully nurtures the congregation so that it might live into its witness to the sovereign activity of God in the world; guides the congregation to become a community of faith, hope, love and witness.
- STEWARDSHIP: collects and provides the financial base which supports our building, personnel, ministries, and programming, thus sustaining and building God's kingdom.
- TRUSTEES: make sure we have a safe, clean, well maintained and welcoming space for worship, fellowship and support of our mission.
- WORSHIP: ensures that worship services are welcoming spaces for all who choose to join us, whether in-person or online; all are welcome at God's table, and we make certain that our table is welcoming, as well.
